# Timeline

**January – December 2004** The Office for National Statistics gathers prevalence data on the mental health of children and young people in Great Britain, in line with its usual five-yearly publication schedule

### October 2013

The chief medical officer, Professor Sally Davies, tells the Department of Health to work with the ONS on a new prevalence survey

#### February 2015

Norman Lamb MP, then the minister of state for care and support, tells *Schools Week* in an exclusive interview that he has secured funding for a new prevalence study

## October 2018

A final deadline is set by NHS Digital for the publication of new data

## August 2005

The last prevalence data on the mental health of children and young people in Great Britain in 2004 is published

## October 2014

The parliamentary education committee raises concerns about the lack of new data on mental health problems in children and young people

#### **2017** The publication deadline for Lamb's survey passes, but nothing is released
